Young Scientists Council at the Polymer Institute of SAS

Young Scientists Council (YSC) at the Polymer Institute is an organization covering all the PhD students, researchers and scientific-technical staff employed on Polymer Institute up to 35 years whose working time is at least 55%. Council has support and motivational functions in generally, in order to develop expertise and personalities of young people at the Polymer Institute.

Council membership is voluntary. Members of Council elect from among themselves a chairman, vice-chairman and two other members of the Bureau of Council on general assembly. Tenure of Bureau is two years and members of the Bureau of Council, can be, if necessary, dismissed and/or replaced. In voting for proposals 50% of all members must be presented. The proposal may be adopted if it is approved by more than 50% of participating members.

Council focuses on:

1. Lecturing activities of Council members, the aim being to inform each other about the focus of members.
2. The advancement of knowledge of Council members in various areas of polymer chemistry and related disciplines.
3. Improving of communication skills of Council members and the ability to present their own work and the obtained results.
4. Improving of English language skills.
5. Supporting of cooperation between members of Council and other young scientists in the frame of Slovak Academy of Sciences and on Universities.
6. Efforts to improve conditions for young people to work in science.
7. Enhancement of non-working and social life of young scientists.
8. Improving facilities for sporting and cultural activities of young people.
